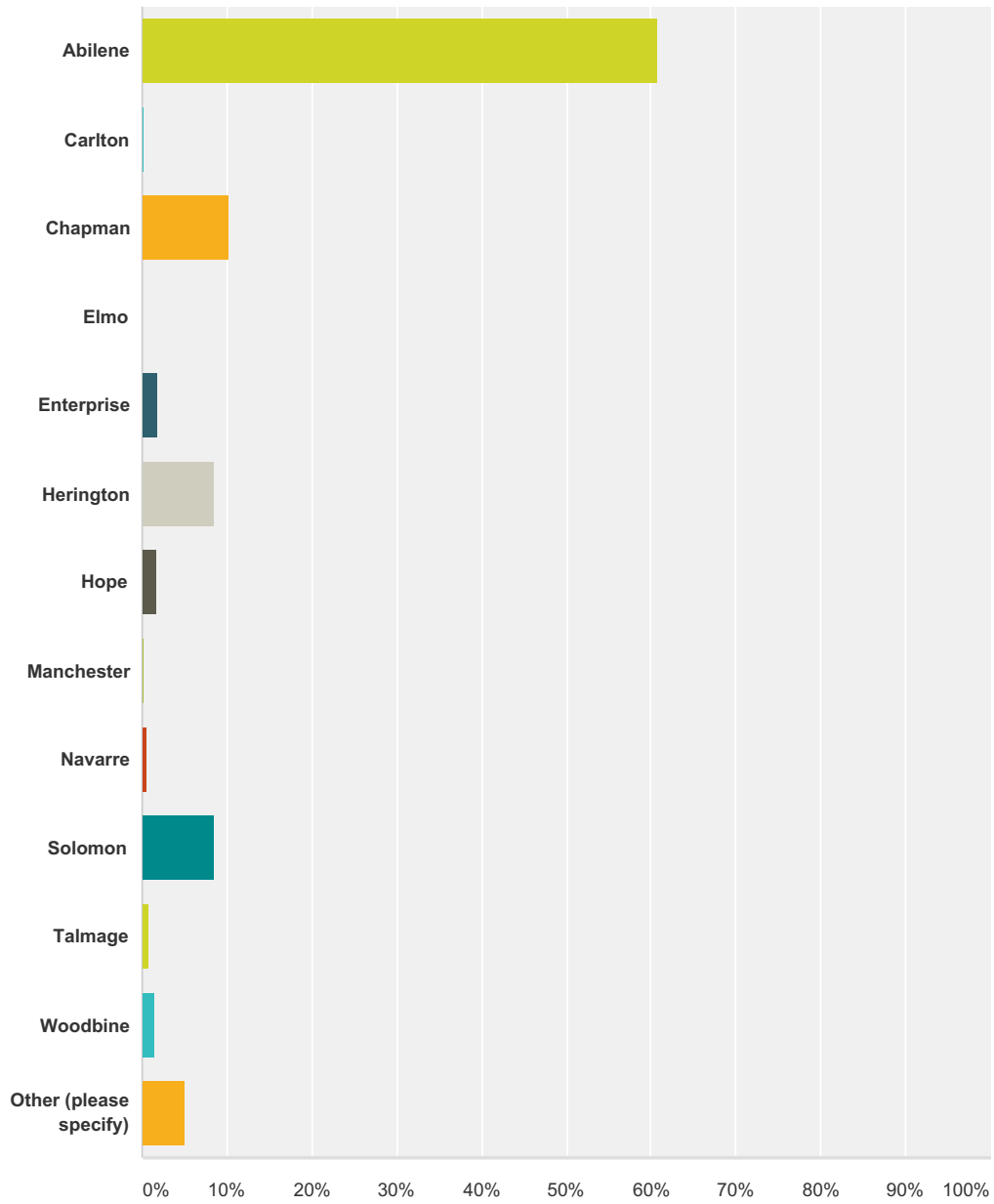

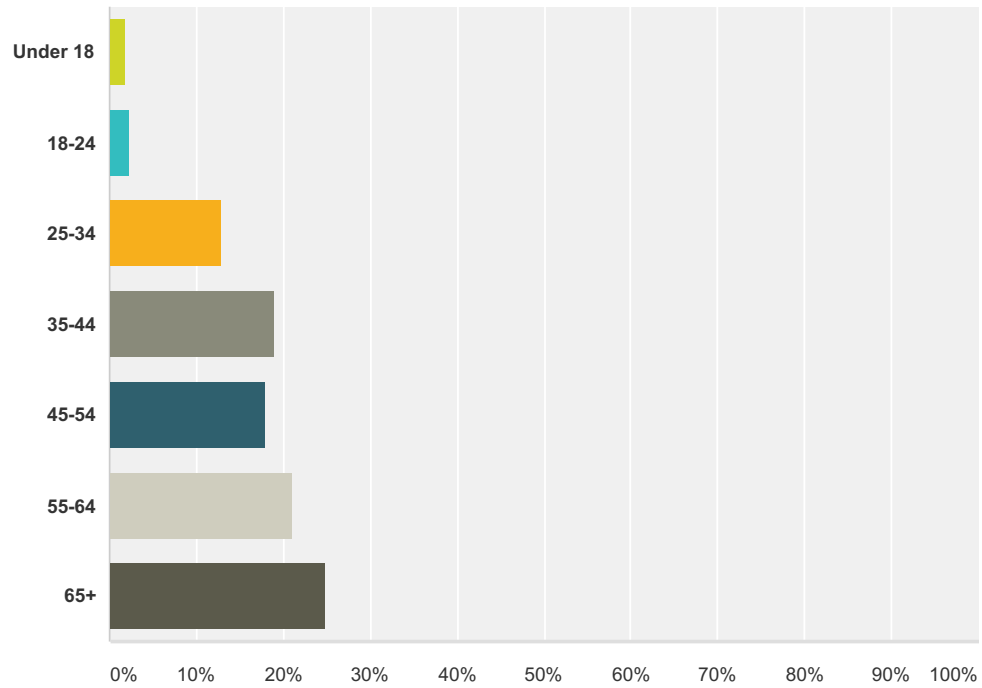

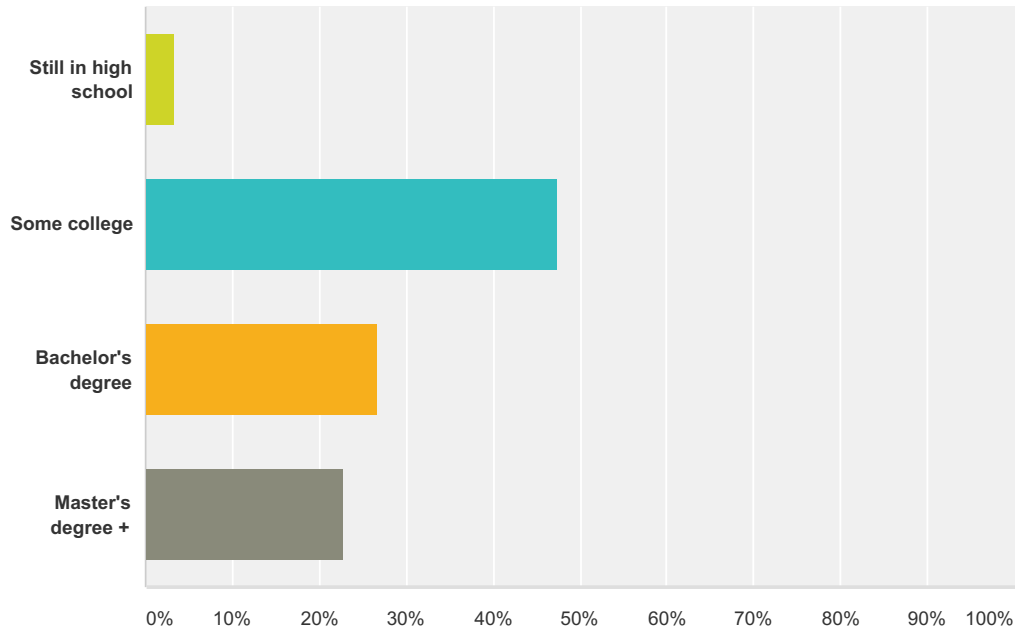

Q3 What is your level of education?

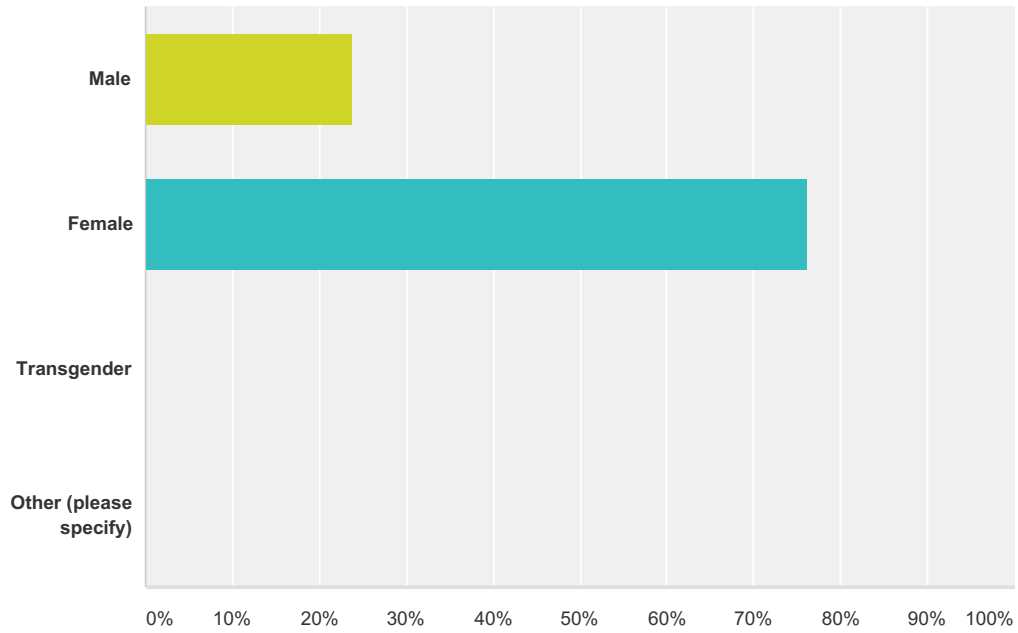

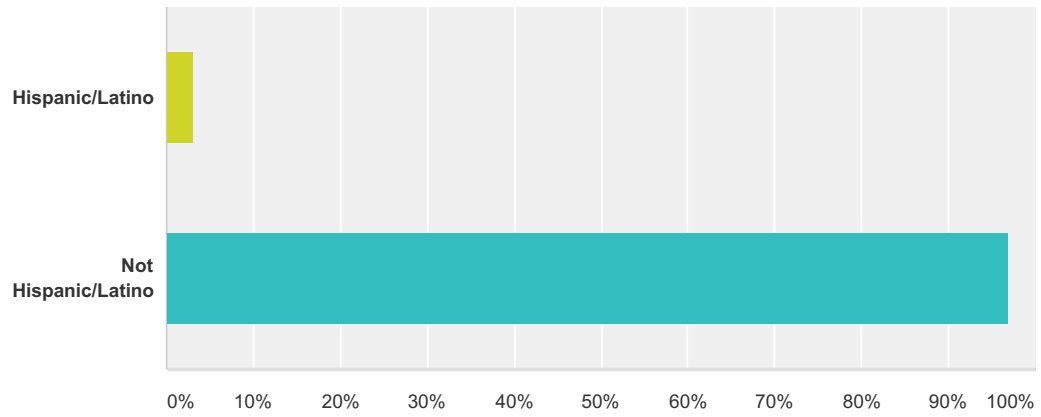

Q5 Chose one ethnic identity.

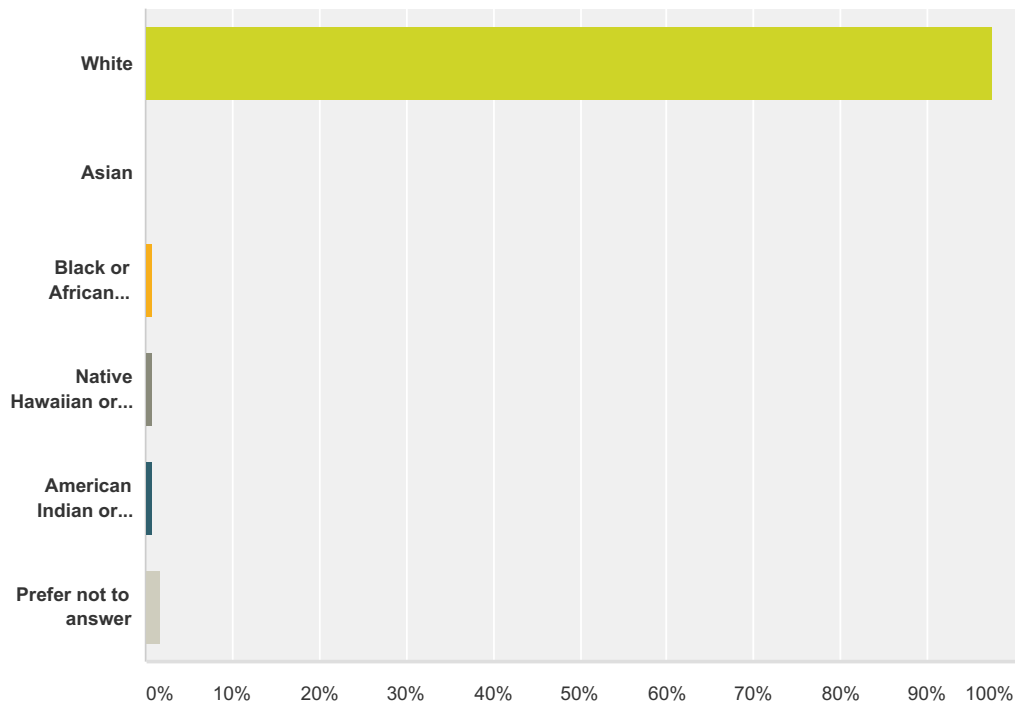

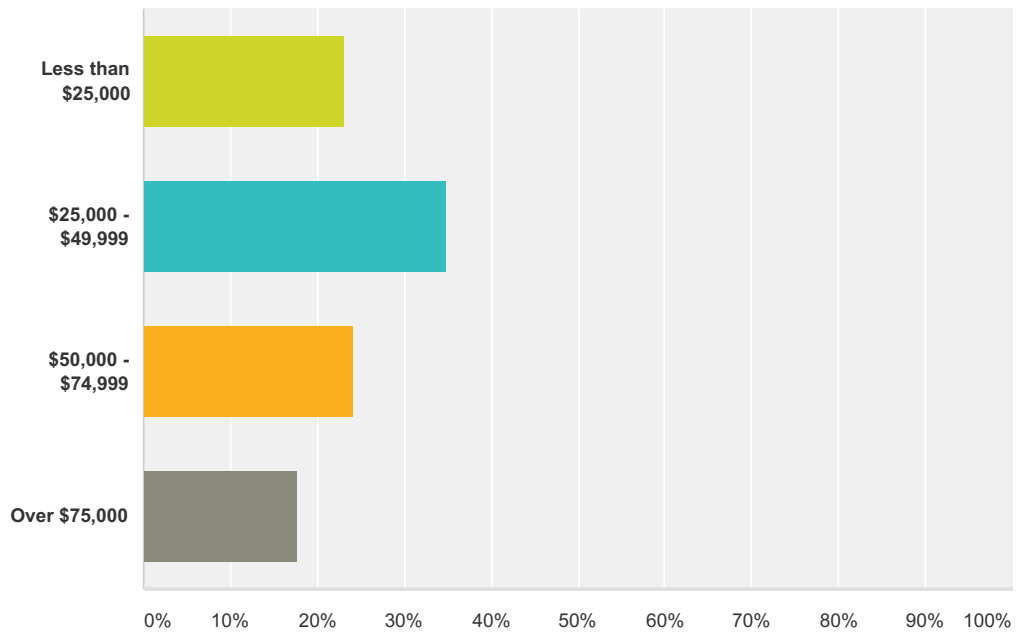

Q7 Please indicate your annual take home pay range.

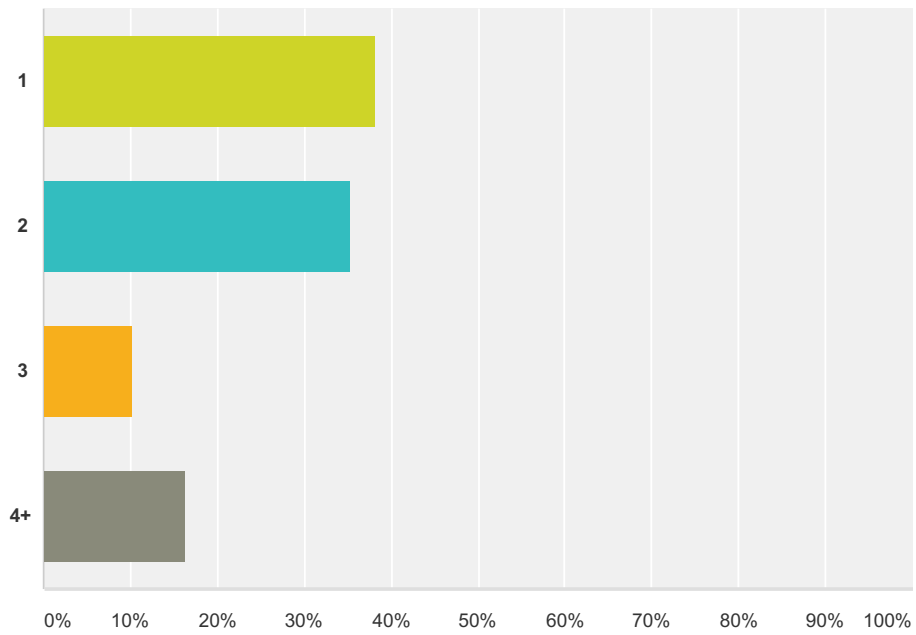

Q8 How many dependents are living in your household?

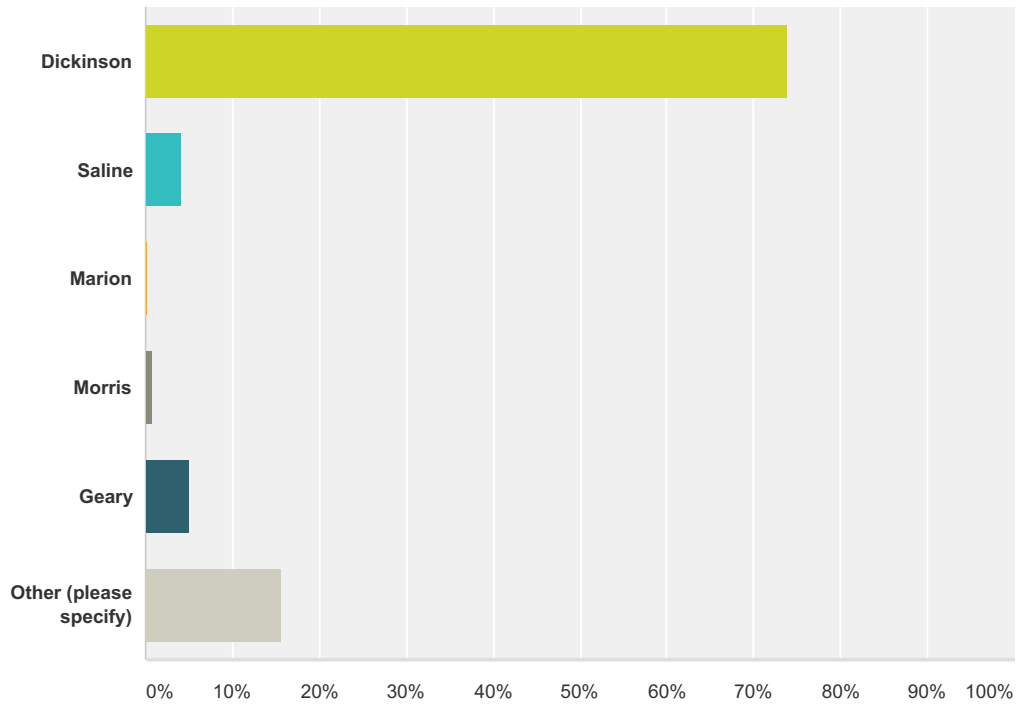

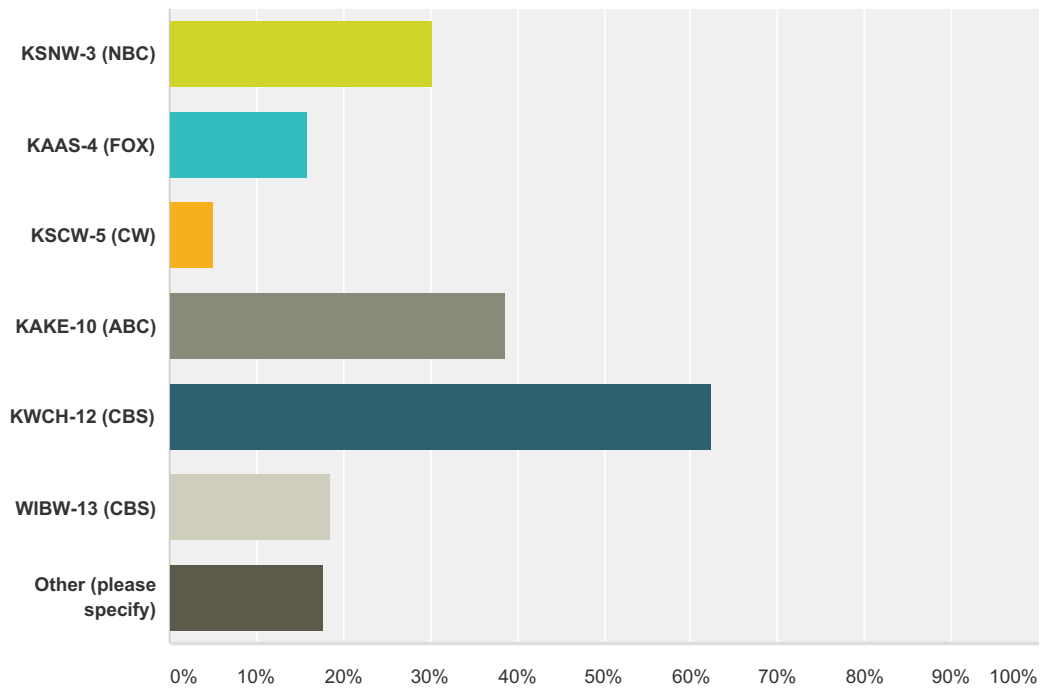

Q15 How would you describe your overall health?

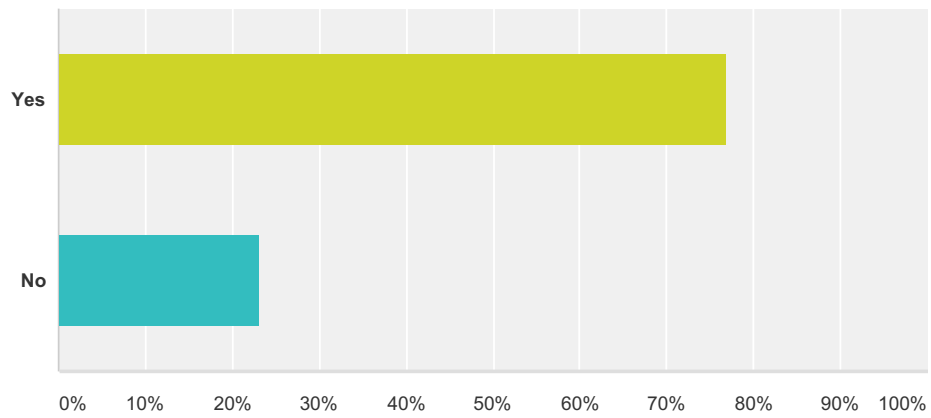

Q16 Are you able to visit a doctor in Dickinson County when needed?

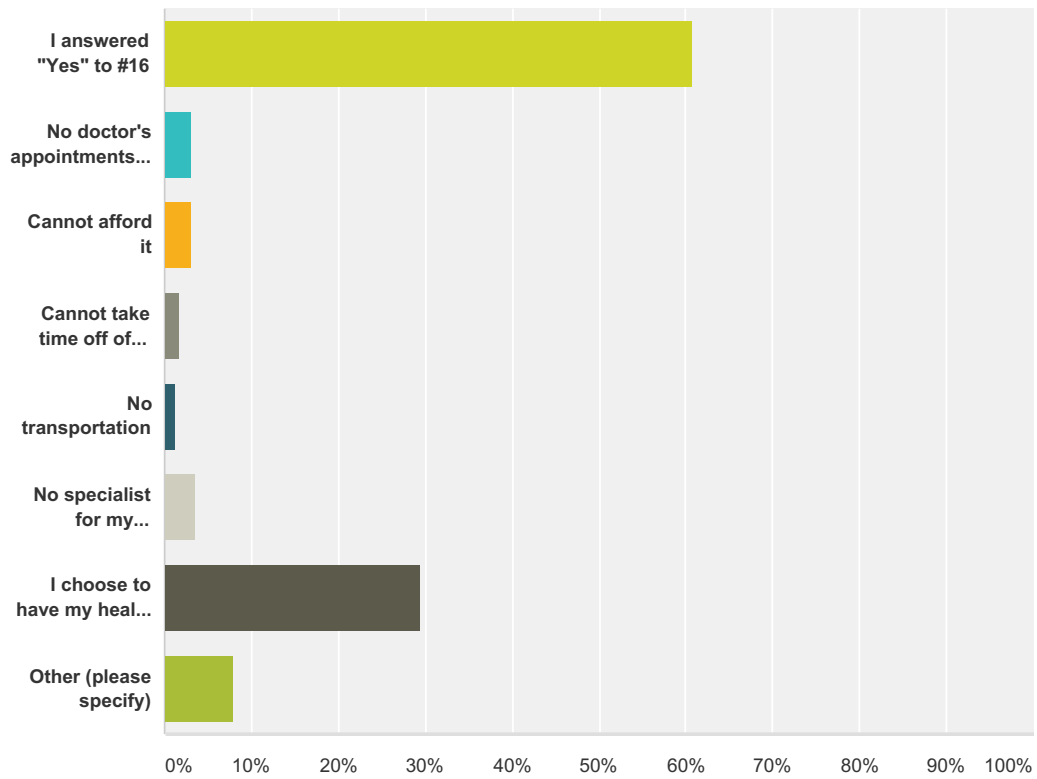

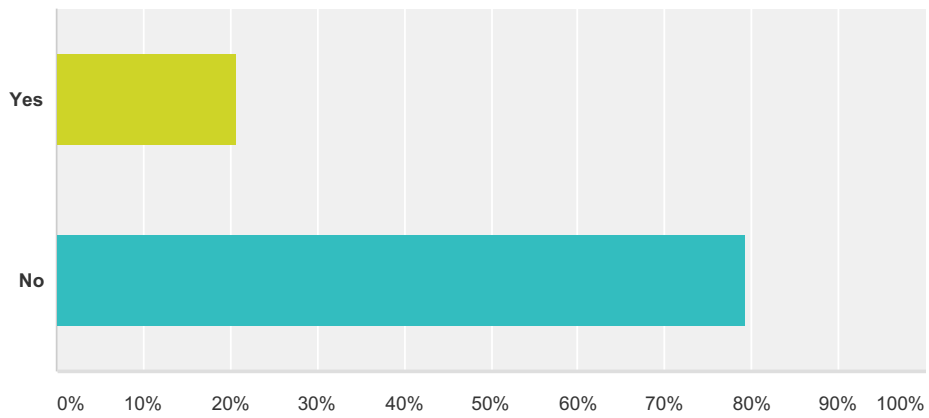
